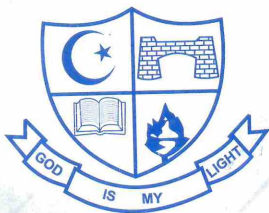
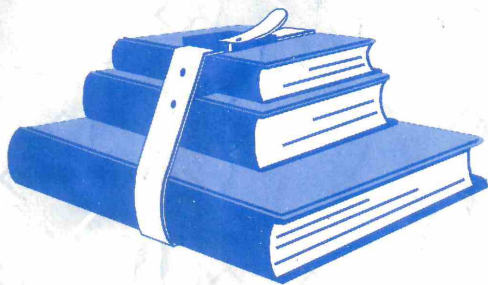

Dear Mr. Muhammad Abbas Khan, Head of the History Department, Edwardes College Peshawar, distinguished guests, dear members of the teaching faculty and the students.

This is our Tenth Annual Academics Day. By the grace of God Almighty, St. Francis' High School has celebrated 13 years of its establishment and I have completed almost 32 years of my commission of teaching in Pakistan. During all these years, I have endeavoured to accomplish my quest and I am blessed enough to see the tree of my efforts bearing excellent fruit in the form of my students who have achieved success in many walks of life. I feel proud to see my old students becoming an asset for the nation.

Mr. Muhammad Abbas Khan, Assistant Professor, Head of the History Department, Edwardes College, Peshawar, is one of those old students of mine who have proven their talents in a competitive environment. He has proved that success is a result of quality education and sincere efforts. With the academic background of St. Mary's High School, Muhammad Abbas Khan proved his flair in Edwardes College as well. During the 160 years of the history of Edwardes College, he has been the only student to hold three top honours simultaneously. After his Masters in History from the University of Peshawar, he joined Edwardes College and soon became the youngest ever head of a department in the college. Since then, not only he has proved his potential in teaching but he also became an asset for the esteemed institution in many ways. He is the Coordinator of the Social Services and Community Action Department at the college and last year he managed to generate aid worth 14 million rupees for the earthquake victims in cash and kind. Mr. Abbas Khan is General Secretary of the Edwardes College Staff Association and is a member of the boards of governors of many orphanages and educational institutes. He is one of the only two trainers for Dreams and Teams Project of British Council in Pakistan. For the last four consecutive years, he has been winning the Excellence Award, the highest award conferred on an individual by the Red Crescent Society, Pakistan. Abbas Khan is still pursuing higher goals. He is doing M.Phil in his subject now. Surely, he is the source of pride for his teachers and inspiration for all the students present here.

But, dear parents and students, inspiration alone is not enough! It must be blended with perspiration to reach the summit in life. It's very unfortunate that the students of today, particularly the boys, evade the hard work and efforts, which are vital to make the dreams of their parents come true. It is very unfortunate that the students fail to avail the facilities and opportunities provided

to them at a school like St. Francis'. Bitter, but true fact is that in most of the cases, the parents are equally responsible for the bleak situation. Let me illustrate with an example. We have the same teachers, teaching the same syllabus, and putting in the same efforts in both the sections. But the girls on the whole perform much better than the boys. More interesting reality is that brothers and sisters from the same family, taught by the same teachers, in the same school come up with a difference of as many as 205 marks in the Board exam! What could be the explanation for such a huge difference?

Ladies and Gentlemen, pondering over the situation for a moment clarifies it reasonably. Parents, along with all the facilities and luxuries, provide uncontrolled freedom to their sons. The boys are seen wasting their time mixing with friends, driving cars, using mobile phones or playing video games all through the evening. Thus, they fail to run an extra mile, which makes the difference between a fair and an excellent result. Here at St. Francis' we do our best to facilitate excellent academic achievement, but all our efforts are pointless, unless they are supplemented with restraints and supervision by the parents at home. As parents, it is your duty to ensure that your children have a balanced, organized and supervised schedule at home. You must put your children as the top priority on your highly committed and busy schedule. Try to confine the facilities to needs, not luxuries. The students of today, are the targets of media warfare, high tech gadgets and swiftly transforming norms and traditions. Try to shield them from being the victims of changing life style. We, as teachers and parents, are collectively responsible for keeping alive the national and religious identity in our new generation. It is our duty to guide and supervise them on the path of success, and if need be, hold their hand firmly to keep them on the right track. I can assure you, that we are performing our job earnestly as teachers. I expect you to carry out yours consistently. I am sure that our joint efforts will bear tremendous results.

I wish to express my gratitude to all of you for taking out time to attend this function today. I am especially thankful to Mr. Muhammad Abbas Khan for being our guest of honour. I hope you all will enjoy proceedings of today. My heartfelt congratulations to those parents whose children are going to get their talents and efforts acknowledged in the form of trophies.
